Reminders:

Dress Code Reminder:

As the weather is changing please make sure your child is dressed appropriately.

Students go out to recess/P.E. everyday so they must be prepared for cold weather!



Shoe/Boot rules:

1) **Are the shoes safe?** Do they slip off while running? Do they cover the toes? Do they have enough traction so that the student doesn't slip and fall?



2) **Do they mark our floors?** No marking blackened soled shoes are allowed.

3) Are they distracting to the learning environment? **No rollers, light-ups, or high heels.** Are they appropriate for mass?

4) They **must have tennis shoes for P.E. everyday.** This is a safety issue for our students.

5) Students may wear boots outside and inside but if they are distracting to the classroom environment, they will be asked to change into their tennis shoes. Students may wear dress shoes to mass. Students will change out of their dress or tennis shoes to their boots after mass is over.
